Thank you for auditioning for our 2019 winter production of "ELF." We will be performing in the Midway Town Hall located at 145 West Main, Midway, Utah.

We will be presenting twelve performances, opening on Saturday, December 14 at 7:30 and closing on Saturday, December 28 with our final 7:30 evening performance. We will not perform on Sundays, Christmas Eve or Christmas Day. Because Midway City has a Swiss Chorus performance on Monday, December 16 in the Town Hall, we will not perform that day as well. We will have matinees at 2 p.m. on Saturday, December 21 and 28.

A talented cast and crew is the first step to a terrific show and the second step is commitment. You must have your lines memorized by the second rehearsal of a particular scene. Your songs must be memorized as quickly as possible. Only with full memorization of a scene can all actors in the scene begin to develop their characters and their relationships to other actors in each scene.
